2. Once a subscription has been successfully submitted, please send a request via email to udi-regulations@teleflex.com and include your GLN, Party Name and the list of Teleflex SKU's that you wish to receive UDI Data for.
3. After all of the above have been verified, Teleflex will then publish the requested data to your data pool and request a Catalog Item Confirmation (CIC) Synchronized message be returned to Teleflex to complete the process.
